



To the South Heartland District Health Department.

KAM Raceway would like to submit a COVID-19 plan that would allow us to expand our capacity by June 22nd, while being mindful of the health measures that others are using to be able to operate their business and still adhere to guidelines brought forth between the SHDHD and CDC. We will do our best to adhere to these guidelines we have set forth until the all clear is given for everyone.

MOST OF ALL, if you are feeling ill, have a fever, cough or other sicknesses, PLEASE STAY HOME

**Pits:**

- COVID-19 Waiver Form MUST BE SIGNED at check in.
- KAM Racers and pit allowance of 8 people per pit parking space will be allowed.
- Please bring your own pen to use at sign in, we will have limited pens available for use. One vehicle at a time may be allowed to come up to check in. But maintain the 6 foot distance rule please.
- During sign in, please stay in your vehicle until it is your turn.
- Masks are highly recommended
- Hand sanitizer will be placed at pit sign in.
- DRIVERS - Melissa will sign you in and draw for you in front of you.
- All transponders will be sanitized before they are handed out and again when they are handed in. You still must give your identification to receive your transponder.
- There will be only reserved parking in effect until the Health Department gives the all clear for our Health District people with a trailer must stay in your own pit parking stall.
- No more than 8 people per trailer. That means the driver/s are included in that 8 count.
- 6 foot social distancing protocols will be in force while watching racing and must be followed. Please keep 6' between you and other viewers at all times whether standing or sitting in the bleachers.
- Viewing from fence will be allowed follow the six foot rule.
- Only one crew member per car in staging.
- No one will be allowed on the general admission side during the races or after the racing is over and will be strictly followed until the Health Department gives the all clear for our Health District.
- No Socializing at the track afterwards Drivers and their guests will need to load up and leave. This will be strictly followed until the Health Department gives the all clear for our Health District.

**Grandstands:**

- Grand Stands will be open. But seating will be limited. No passes or wheeler dealers will be accepted for now. **The 75% capacity on the general admission side is 675 people and will be strictly followed until the Health Department gives the all clear for our Health District.**
- MASKS will be highly recommended for adults and children over the age of 2 - Bring your own we will not have any to offer for use or sale. Children will be required to sit with their families. If they are running around and not with their parent you will be asked to leave.
- You will be required to fill out a health form stating you have no signs of COVID and it we will need a signature, address and phone number where you can be reached if needed. This will be downloadable online from our website and it is recommended you fill it out and sign it before you get there, look for General Admission Form. Turn it into the cashier. ( [kamraceway.com](http://kamraceway.com) ) We will have them on hand but please to keep the line moving bring yours with you.
- Hand Sanitizer will be available at the gate.
- Social Distancing will be required. There will be blue flags in the grass ditch area along the fence to help with the 6 foot rule. This will be self policed although we will step in if needed. Families can sit together but there MUST be a 6 foot space in-between you and other groups. Please leave a bench in-between you and others in front of you.
- If you are standing and watching be mindful of the 6 feet rule.
- For exiting purposed there is the entry/exit gate and the larger gate by the bathrooms will be opened when racing is over. When racing is over please exit through these areas and be aware of social distancing.
- No one will be allowed in the pits during the races or after the racing is over and will be strictly followed until the Health Department gives the all clear for our Health District.

**Concessions:**

- Concessions will be open with distancing measures in place. While standing in line maintain the 6 foot rule.
- Glass windows are all ready between the server and customer and hand sanitizer will be available.
- Concession workers will wear masks and have gloves or hand sanitizer available. We will limit the number in the concession stand.
- Food will be limited to Pizza (Godfathers), **hot dogs**, popcorn, Pepsi products and candy bars.

**Workers:**

- A forehead temperature will be taken when you sign in and it will be recorded. If you have a temperature of 100.4F or above or symptoms of COVID-19 you will be asked to leave and you will be encouraged to call your health professional and get tested. If you are not well before the race text us and please stay home.
- **You all will be required to sign a COVID-19 waiver form at check in. You can print this off at our website and bring it with you to help sign in go faster. ( [kamraceway.com](http://kamraceway.com) Pit Admission Form) You will need to do this every week.**
- We will have a infection control mitigation person who will maintain cleaning of the handrails and restrooms also anywhere that people have had contact with a surface.

- The infection control mitigation person will also enforce verbally the 6 foot distance rule whenever necessary.
- It is suggested you wear a mask please bring your own if you can. There will be masks provided for check in workers and concession workers because of CDC rules. If they are cloth turn those back in afterwards so they can be washed.
- On Track workers wearing a mask is recommended and please be mindful of the 6 foot distance rule also. If there is a wreck we want you to help but keep the help to those who are only necessary.
- Everyone but essential clean up personal must leave after the racing is over. No Socializing at the track afterwards and will be strictly followed until the Health Department gives the all clear for our Health District.
- Only Essential workers will be allowed in the pit no extra family members until the Health Department gives the all clear for our Health District.

Most of all, we ask that you be respectful during this process and adhere to our rules to operate. We know it's not ideal, not in the slightest. Our goal is to provide a safe positive place for racers and fans.

If you feel it is unsafe or you are sick, please stay at home. With that being said, KAM will not tolerate negativity on our facebook site and if it happens, you will be banned from the page and face possible suspension from the grounds.

Hang in there with us as we try to make this work!

We know you are all missing Friday nights at the track but WE also don't want to be a part of the bigger problem. If there are problems and issues we could be shut down.

As always, there's a lot on the table for the state in opening some things back up in June and the situation is always fluid. If the state does good through this new phase and COVID numbers stay low these restrictions will be addressed again in July.
